



## ANGLICAN 4<sup>th</sup> DAY SPONSORSHIP

The

*Diocese of Cascadia's 4<sup>th</sup> Day Weekend is an annual opportunity for mature Christian members of the church to enhance their relationship with the Lord. When prayerfully choosing a Candidate, a Sponsor should seek a baptized adult who is a regular participant in worship and a potential leader with a sincere desire to grow in their faith.*

The opportunity to attend an Anglican 4<sup>th</sup> Day weekend is offered, with no cost or fees to the candidate, because of the joy of giving of alumni of Anglican 4<sup>th</sup> Day, Cursillo, Walk to Emmaus, Via de Christo, etc., who prayerfully commit to sponsoring the candidate for an Anglican 4<sup>th</sup> Day Weekend.

4<sup>th</sup> Day Sponsorship is a privilege which involves several important responsibilities. It is not only providing financial support, but is also a long-term commitment to the candidate by:

- Praying for the Candidate before, during, and after the 4<sup>th</sup> Day weekend
- Assisting the Candidate to participate regularly in a Group Reunion as they develop prayer life
- Guiding the Candidate to become a witnessing member of the 4<sup>th</sup> Day community and to give back by sponsoring a future Candidate

### A SPONSOR:

1. Accepts completely and signs the Diocese of Cascadia's Declaration of Faith (link online).
2. Discusses the value of participation in the 4<sup>th</sup> Day Weekend with the candidate.
3. Completes Candidate Registration form online at the Diocese of Cascadia's website.
4. Takes the candidate to the weekend or arranges transportation when necessary.
5. Prays for the Candidate prior to, during, and after the Weekend.
6. Greets the candidate at the end of the Weekend for Clausura, and takes them home, or arranges transportation when necessary.
7. Spends time with the candidate in the weeks following the weekend.
8. Supports and encourages the candidate to become a participant in Group Reunion.
9. Accompanies candidate to available 4<sup>th</sup> Day Workshops and Ultreyas.
10. Continues to pray for candidate's continued growth.

## Diocese of Cascadia's Declaration of Faith

1. As a Christian and member of the Body of Christ I believe in one holy, catholic and apostolic church of Jesus Christ. I believe and confess Jesus Christ to be the Way, the Truth and the Life and that no one comes to the Father, but by Him;
1. I accept and uphold the authority of Scripture (Old and New Testaments) and believe them to be the inspired Word of God, containing all things necessary for my salvation, and to be the final authority and unchangeable standard to Christian faith and life;
2. I confess as expressed in the Holy Scripture the historic faith of the church as declared in the Apostles' and Nicene Creeds; and the Jerusalem Declaration (Jerusalem Declaration on reverse side).
3. I seek to be an obedient disciple of Jesus Christ my one Lord and Savior and work to order my life according to Biblical precepts and received Faith and Order.
4. I accept the original intent and methodology of the Diocese of Cascadia's Anglican 4<sup>th</sup> Day movement's "Three Day Weekend" which includes fifteen talks, as one talk, and five meditations; including the full expression of sacraments as found in the context of the historical, orthodox, tradition of the Diocese of Cascadia's Anglican 4<sup>th</sup> Day movement; And
5. I will continue in the tradition of the essence and core principles found in the original Cursillo® methodology/movement.
